The optional jumping group will move at a pace that suits the heat of the day and will have a 2nd leader to take non-jumpers around a fence or through gates as needed. Participants must sign a waiver and show a copy of a current negative Coggins the day of the ride. **Helmets are recommended for all riders and required for juniors.** Please leave pets at home and bring water for your horses.
